EU SHIFTS ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDING AWAY FROM GAS, INTO ELECTRICITY GRIDS

The European Commission on Tuesday (15 December) proposed rules to restrict EU funding for natural gas infrastructure and instead funnel cash into electricity and low-carbon energy networks to meet climate goals.
The EUs Trans-European Energy Networks rules, or TEN-E, define which cross-border energy projects are eligible to receive EU funding and fast-tracked permits.
The Commission on Tuesday proposed to rewrite those rules, which guided imbillion in EU cash to cross-border energy projects over the last decade, including power grids and gas pipelines.
