## SLOVENIA: NEWCOMER SET TO OUST RIGHT-WING PREMIER JANSA

A small liberal party headed by political newcomer Robert Golob surged ahead of Slovenia's threetime Prime Minister Janez Jansa's conservatives in elections on Sunday, partial results showed.

With more than half the votes counted, Golob's Freedom Movement (GS) stood at almost 33% of the vote compared to 25% for Jansa's Slovenian Democratic Party.

Observers have said neither party is likely to receive enough votes to rule outright, making a coalition government highly probable.

Some 1.7 million people from a population of 2.1 million were eligible to vote in the 90-member legislature.
