CRUNCH TIME IN POLAND FOR TACKLING EU RULE OF LAW DISPUTE

Years of bitter battles between Poland and the EU over allegations that the countrys nationalist government hobbled the independence of its courts which is holding up billions in EU funds come to a head this week.
The Polish parliament is due to take a final vote on a bill that rolls back some of those reforms, aimed at meeting milestones set out by the European Commission to release $\ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ $
The lower house of parliament, the Sejm, moved into action on Monday, with the justice and human rights committee stripping out all 14 amendments added to the bill by the opposition-controlled Senate. The full Sejm, which is narrowly controlled by the ruling United Right coalition, is expected to vote on the full bill by Wednesday. It would then go for a signature to President Andrzej Duda.
