Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Sri Lankan President Anura Kumara Dissanayake, also known as AKD, who is on his first overseas trip since being elected in September, during their meeting on Monday reaffirmed their commitment to enhanced bilateral cooperation.

Modi hosted Dissanayake at Hyderabad House, where the two leaders held bilateral "comprehensive and fruitful" talks, according to a statement from the Indian Foreign Ministry.

Dissanayake arrived in India on Sunday evening, beginning a three-day state visit.
