BELARUS'S LUKASHENKO BECOMES SECOND ONLY LEADER TO VISIT MYANMAR SINCE COUP

Belarusian President Alexander Lukashenko has arrived in Myanmar on a goodwill visit seen as lending support to the Southeast Asian countrys military government in advance of a widely condemned national election set to be held next month.

Myanmar state media reported on Friday that Senior General Min Aung Hlaing, the countrys self-installed de facto leader, met Lukashenko at the Presidential Palace in the capital, Naypyidaw.

This visit demonstrated Belaruss goodwill and trust towards Myanmar and marked a historic occasion. It is the first time in 26 years of diplomatic relations that a Belarusian Head of State has visited Myanmar, military run outlet The Global New Light of Myanmar reported.
