
PASHINYAN BACKS LINKING ARMENIA'S ENERGY GRID WITH TÜRKİYE, AZERBAIJAN

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Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan said Thursday that linking Armenias energy network with those of Türkiye and Azerbaijan would boost export capacity and support regional peace, Armenpress reported.

Speaking at a press briefing, Pashinyan dismissed claims that integrating energy networks with Baku would be counterproductive due to existing energy surpluses in both nations.

He said Armenias grid is currently only linked with Georgia and Iran, emphasizing that new connections would provide access to larger international markets.

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
