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## HOUSE OF TURKISH WEIGHTLIFTING LEGEND SÜLEYMANOĞLU TURNED INTO MUSEUM

*The childhood home of legendary Turkish weightlifter Naim Süleymanoğlu – the Pocket Hercules who rewrote Olympic history – will open as a museum in Bulgaria on Nov. 18, offering visitors a rare glimpse into the early life of one of the sports greatest champions.*
