
UZBEKISTAN LAUNCHES SECOND TERMIZ DIALOGUE ON INTERREGIONAL COOPERATION

The opening session of Termiz Dialogue on Connectivity between Central and South Asia highlighted discussions on regional connectivity, economic cooperation, transport corridors, energy links, climate resilience, and cultural and humanitarian engagement as key pillars of interregional integration, Trend reports via the Institute for Strategic and Interregional Studies under the President of Uzbekistan.

Eldor Aripov, Director of the Institute for Strategic and Interregional Studies, described the Termiz Dialogue as a practical implementation of President Shavkat Mirziyoyevs initiative to strengthen connectivity between Central and South Asia. He noted that the concept has received broad international support, including a 2022 UN General Assembly resolution that established a long-term legal foundation for transregional cooperation.

Aripov said the platform has already produced tangible results, contributing to trust-building and the development of practical initiatives involving governments, international organizations, the private sector, and civil society.

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
